\*\*You will need to add all your children to PS parent portal if you have not done so yet.

**FOR FAMILIES: Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB)**

This program, run by the Federal Communications Commission, offers a monthly discount to offset the cost of broadband Internet subscriptions, helping those that are struggling with connectivity, pathways to stay connected. In addition, the program provides a one-time discount on a laptop, desktop, or tablet computer.

The FCC announced that enrollment for the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program begins May 12, 2021.

**Who is eligible?**

A household is eligible if one member of the household:

- Qualifies for the **Lifeline** program;
- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, or did so in the 2019-2020 school year;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
