The City of Lincoln is planning to make improvements to infrastructure in your area. This postcard provides information on the project, what to expect during construction, and additional resources to assist with navigating around Lincoln.

CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW

Lincoln Transportation and Utilities (LTU) is planning residential street improvements in the Eastborough neighborhood, including the following streets:

- Glenhaven Dr from W Rio Rd to Dotson Rd
- 75th St from Steinway Rd to Dotson Rd
- Dotson Rd from Avon Ln to W Broadview Dr
- Indian Rd from Steinway Rd to Trail Ridge Rd
- Terrace Rd from Steinway Rd to Trail Ridge Rd
- Trail Ridge Rd from Broadview Dr to 81st St
- 81st St from Trail Ridge Rd to Vine St

SCOPE OF WORK

Construction will include a mill and overlay, as well as concrete repairs and curb replacement where necessary. A sidewalk will be constructed on the south side of Trail Ridge Rd between N 81st St and Ruswood Blvd. Existing curb ramps will be updated to comply with the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.


Construction is anticipated to begin in spring 2026 and be completed in fall 2026.

ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Streets will be closed to through traffic during construction, but local access will be maintained when possible. Sidewalks and curb ramps will be closed during reconstruction. Sidewalk access will be maintained for pedestrians on at least one side of the street.
