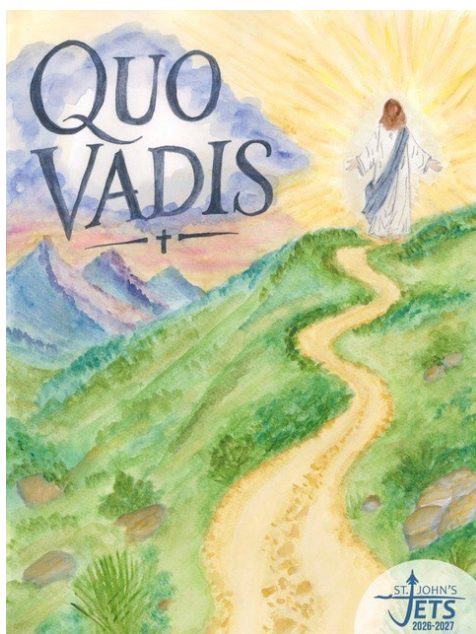

Illnesses/Absences

Sending an email is the easiest way to notify us of absences to St.John's-Office@cdolinc.net. Please provide the reason they are absent and symptoms of illness. A written note sent in will work also.

Symptoms that require absence from school are: **FEVER over 100.4 and students must be fever-free without fever-reducing medications for a full 24 hours before return to school, vomiting and/or diarrhea and must be symptom-free for a full 24 hours before return to school.**

If/when your student has **appointments** and is absent from school, please let us know via email for our absence reports. This alleviates a phone call to you to find out where they are. When you bring your student to school later

than 8am, you bring your students into the school to sign them in or out.

Title I Support Services

This year our school will receive support through a special program called **Title I**. This program helps schools like ours provide extra learning support for students, especially in **reading and math**. Here’s how Title I helps our school:

Extra Learning Help

Some students get small-group or one-on-one time with a teacher to practice important skills.

More Learning Tools

We use Title I funds to get books, technology, and hands-on materials to make learning fun and effective.

Support for Teachers

Teachers will receive extra training to learn new ways to help every student succeed.

Paperless School

St. John’s is a paperless school. This gives you easy access to information regarding your students and the school 24/7. We have the school website, PowerSchool Parent Portal, and emailed weekly parent notes.

PowerSchool Parent Portal

PowerSchool (PS) helps parents to access student grades and see assignments, teacher communications, class resources, etc. Please use the link at the top of the parent note for PowerSchool.

School Forms – Prescription Medications

If your child has specific medical needs, and you have not contacted us yet, please make us aware of those ASAP. Any prescription medications **MUST** have forms from the office completed by physician and/or student/parents and returned. Please send any medications needed to the office, in the **ORIGINAL** containers (prescription bottles with labels included), with the prescription label on the container. Please call the school office if you have questions.

****NEW** this year, all medication forms have changed and must be completed annually.

School SCRIP Program 2026-2027

SCRIP is a gift card program we have that all purchases help you ‘give back’ to St. John’s without spending extra money! You make your purchase (in house or online) and the percentage the business gives back to the church. We use RaiseRight Fundraising.

BackPack SCRIP means you send your order and payment with your student in the morning, we fill your order during the day, and the order is returned to you for delivery back home. We will also provide a list of SCRIP options that are local and what normally is in stock for you. SCRIP waivers will be coming soon for completion and to allow your BackPack SCRIP use. There are more than 750 brands to use online, some are actual gift cards, and some have e-cards. The ecards come directly to the app you downloaded to your phone to use, and the church still gets the percentage back. www.raiseright.com to find out more information.

If you are not using the backpack SCRIP program, you will need to go to the church office to get your order filled or after weekend masses. You may also contact Nancy Wolf at nancyfitzwolf@aol.com for questions or special orders.

CIPA (Children’s Internet Protection Act)

The Diocese of Lincoln Schools cooperates fully with the Children’s Internet Protection Act. Since July 1, 2002, when the diocese began participating in the e-rate program, we have enforced the following strategies to keep students safe on the Internet.

- 1. Appropriate Use Agreements (on enrollment/re-enrollment online forms)
- 2. Adult supervision of all use of the Internet by students.
- 3. iSafe Internet Safety curriculum, approved by the local administrator.
- 4. Forcepoint Internet filtering
